**WHAT CONSTITUTES RAGGING**

- Any conduct, whether by words spoken or written or by an act, which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness any other student.
- Indulging in rowdy or indisciplined activities which causes or likely to cause annoyance, hardship or psychological harm or raise fear/ apprehension thereof in a fresher or junior student.
- Asking a fresher or a junior student to do any act or perform something which such student will not in the ordinary course and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame or embarrassment so as to adversely affect her physical or psychological well being.

**RAGGING IS AN OFFENSE PUNISHABLE  
BY LAW.**

**PUNISHABLE INGREDIENTS OF  
RAGGING**

- Abetment to ragging.
- Criminal conspiracy to rag.
- Unlawful assembly and rioting while ragging.
- Public nuisance created during ragging.
- Violation of decency and morals through ragging.
- Injury to body, causing hurt or grievous hurt.
- Wrongful restraint.
- Wrongful Confinement
- Use of Criminal Force.
- Assault as well as sexual offences or unnatural Offenses.
- Extortion.
- Criminal intimidation
- Attempts to commit any or all of the above mentioned offenses against victim(s).
- Physical or psychological humiliation.

**UGC REGULATIONS ON CURBING THE MENACE OF RAGGING IN  
INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION**

Students found guilty of the offence of ragging may be penalized in one or more of the following manner:

1. Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges.
2. Debarring from appearing in any test/examination or other evaluation.
3. Withholding results.
4. Suspension/Expulsion from the hostel.
5. Cancellation of admission.
6. Rustication from the institution for period ranging from 1 to 4 Semesters.
7. Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution for a specific period.
8. Fine ranging between Rs. 25,000/- & Rupees 1 lakh.
9. Debarring from representing the institution in any regional , national or international meet , tournament, Youth festival e.t.c.
10. Withdrawing/withholding scholarship / fellowship and other benefits.
11. Collective Punishment: When the persons committing or abetting ragging are not identified the institution shall resort to collective punishment.
