From the semester-II / IV beginning from December, 2008 the pattern of structured tests adopted by the college has been changed to class room tests. Henceforth a C.A. test will be conducted in the regular classes of the respective paper. The regular teaching schedule as per the time-table will be followed in other periods of the day.

The Continuous Assessment Tests for Semester II & IV and COSD will be held between **20th February, 2009 and 12th March, 2009.**

The dates for the test of individual subjects / papers will be announced by respective teachers in their classes. A formal notice regarding the same will also be put up on the notice board and the college website.

The C.A. due papers of Semester-II for students of Semester-IV and COSD programmes will be conducted after the regular CA tests of Sem.II, IV and COSD programmes. These will be in the form of organized tests of 45 minutes duration, for which the dates will be announced by the Controller of Examinations.

PATTERN OF QUESTION PAPERS

The maximum marks for each paper in the C.A. Tests will be 15. The pattern of the Question paper will be as follows:

Course for the Test : The C.A. test papers will be set from two units of the syllabi of the respective papers as specified by the teachers in the class.

There will be three sections A, B & C in the paper :

Section A: will contain 5 objective type questions of 1 mark each, with atleast two questions from each of the two units included in the test. All questions will be compulsory.

Section B : will contain four questions, with two questions (with internal choice) from each unit. The students will be required to answer two questions in all, taking one question from each unit. Each question will be of two marks.

Section C : will contain two questions in all, taking one question from each unit. The students are required to answer any one question in about 300-400 words. Each question will carry 6 marks.

Question papers in languages may have a different pattern, to be announced in the class room by the respective teachers.

Duration : The duration of the test will be 45 minutes.
