

Admission Policy

Generally the admission procedure for the new academic year is conducted during Feb/March. However for overseas students special consideration could be allowed.

The IIS, Jaipur is unbiased as to gender, language, class, caste or creed. Interactive sessions with candidates and parents initiate the admission process. Students from Class X onwards will be assessed in key areas of their prior learning, after the interactive sessions. The IIS reserves the right to award admission.

- 1. All applications must be duly filled in, signed and submitted within 3 days from the date of collection of forms by the last prescribed date.
- 2. Originals will have to be produced for verification.
- 3. All applications must be accompanied with THREE passport size photographs, Birth Certificate (attested by a gazetted officer) or the Leaving Certificate as the case may be and a Medical Certificate from the family doctor.
- 4. Assessment of the Admission Form will be done by the Admissions Office.
- 5. Entrance Tests to determine the student's proficiency in Math and English may be conducted. The language proficiency test may be conducted to determine the aptitude and to guide the students for the language options offered in IBDP
- 6. Intimation to the parent regarding the interaction date will be communicated in due course.
- 7. Information conveyed to the parent about the admission status.
- 8. Fees have to be paid on or before the due date.
- 9. Submission of Application Form does not ensure admission to the school.
- 10. A student is admitted on a provisional basis till all necessary documentation is submitted.
- 11. After confirmation of admission the student is expected to undergo a complete medical checkup and the report submitted to the school office before the commencement of the school. The report should not be more than 60 days old.
- 12. In case any relevant information has been withheld deliberately, the school may review the admission of the student.
- 13. The fee structure is subject to change at the discretion of the school management.
- 14. The decision of the school authorities regarding admission shall be final and binding.
