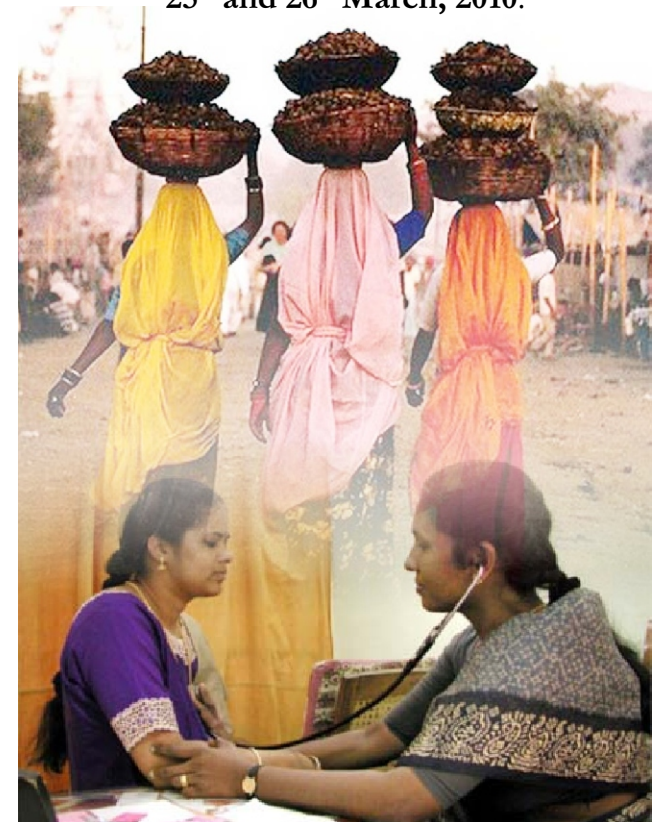

Two hard copies of the abstract must accompany the registration form along with requisite registration fee. The submission of CD is a must if not sent by email. Only registered delegates can submit abstracts for presentation. For power point presenters LCD-computer will be arranged by the organizers. The full paper will be called for after approval of abstracts.
