## A WORD TO THE PARENT

We follow a Periodic Evaluation system for assessment:

- Parents to ensure that their ward attends the school regularly.
- Periodic Tests/Assessments, Term End Exams and Subject Enrichment Activities (SEAs) are conducted at regular intervals after proper revisions. The tentative dates for examinations are mentioned in the school diary.
- Marks are given for each mode of assessments and are converted into grades.
- Please refer to Page No. A-23 to A-25 of the school diary for Grade Scheme.
- Blue Print of exams will be given to students well in advance for the general idea of the Marking Scheme and question paper pattern.

Our experimental approach to education ensures that learning continues long after the bell announces the end of a school day. We encourage students to become lifelong learners. The teaching skills focus on deep understanding and build **Critical Thinking, Communication and Collaboration Skills**. Smart class adds to this by easing and enhancing the learning process.
