6. CYBER

Activity: Cyber Crime & Cyber Security News Collage

Objective: To create awareness about cyber crime and cyber security by collecting real news articles.

Materials Needed: {Newspapers (national and regional), Scissors, Glue or adhesive, A chart paper (A2 or A3 size), Sketch pens or markers}

Steps:

1. Collect Newspapers: Read newspaper daily. Look for both English and Hindi papers for wider coverage.
2. Scan for Articles: Search for all articles related to:
 - Cyber-crime (e.g., online frauds, phishing scams, cyberbullying, data breaches)
 - Cyber security (e.g., security tips, government initiatives, technological developments)
3. Cut and Sort: Cut out all the related news items neatly. Sort them into two groups: Cyber Crime and Cyber Security
4. Plan the Layout: Divide your chart into two sections: (Left: Cyber Crime; Right: Cyber Security)
5. Paste the Cuttings: Arrange the news clippings creatively, ensure all headlines are visible.
6. Add Headings and Decorations: Use sketch pens to label each section. You can also add small captions, facts, or statistics.
7. Final Touch: Add a title at the top like "Cyber Awareness Collage" and include your name/class in a corner.

7. HERITAGE AND TOURISM

Guidelines:
