The panelists were Mr. Prateek Arora, Founder, BULBCAFE, Mr Kartik Arora, Founder, of Triloki Trademart (Moon Child Decor & Dry fruits), Mr. Ankur Jain, Founder, Jaipur Homes, and Mr. Himalay Singh, Founder, Wedding world event company.

The panelists began the conversation by describing their entrepreneurial experiences and difficulties while establishing their enterprises. They outlined the importance of daily learning, perseverance, rigour, and creativity to develop answers to unforeseen challenges. They discussed their experience of failures and emphasised to the students that it is essential not to take failures too seriously and to look for alternative ways to succeed.
