#### Ramayan Conference

With the lighting of lamp and seeking blessings from the Lord Almighty two day Second International Ramayana Conference was organized in International School of Informatics and Management, Technical Campus (IIIM) in collaboration with AIMS International and Shri Ram Charitra Bhawan, USA on 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> January, 2019.


