Introduction :

IIS, Jaipur is inclusive & unbiased as to grounds of race, nationality or national origin, ethnicity, culture, gender, age, sexual orientation, religious affiliation, political beliefs, disability or any other personal characteristic as prohibited by law. IIS offers admission to students from grade Kg to 12th in CBSE (National Board) and Cambridge (Class I to IX) and IB (Class XI) (International Boards).

In the present scenario of global competitive world one needs to think critically and analyse the situation. Accordingly the school prepares the students to face multi-task situations.

Admission procedure for the next academic year is conducted during December/January. However for overseas students special consideration could be allowed

Interactive sessions with candidates and parents initiate the admission process. Students from Class IX onwards is assessed in key areas of their prior learning, after the interactive sessions. IIS reserves the right to grant admission.

For CBSE Wing (only for girls till X standard) : admissions are majorly done at the entry level i.e. KG1 & Grade 1 with a specified criteria (weblink). For other classes admission is granted only if there is vacancy against transfer case and that also only to the deserving candidate (criteria based and those capable of coping up).



RTE

As per the directive by the Government of India and as per Govt. of Rajasthan notification no. शिशिरा / प्रारं/आर.टी.ई/9626/ शि:िुल्क/ 10-11/िो-1/127 dated 3rd November, 2011 25% of the seats at the entry point (i.e. KG-I) are reserved for RTE for weaker section of society.

For **Hostel Admission** from 6th onwards (only for girls) at IIS preference is given to the students from other states / countries, that brings in diversity.

For International Wing (Co-ed): students from within the school & from outside may seek admission as per the criteria (weblink) & vacancy at the following levels:

- Cambridge Primary Programme - class 1 to 5 (vacancy based)
- Cambridge Lower Secondary Programme – class 6 to 8 (vacancy based)
- IGCSE Year 1 (Age : 14 years and above & vacancy based)
- IBDP Year 1 (Age : 16 years & vacancy based)



IBDP

Enrolment Process :

1. Admission announcement for IB is done by circular/advertisement.
2. For new students admission circular/guide lines are made available on school web.www.icfia.org & www.iisjaipur.org
3. In house announcement of admissions is done through class room counseling and circulars to the parents. Besides this advertisement is done through posters in the campus.
4. Application forms is provided in the 'ready reckoner' kit
5. This is followed by 1:1 counseling sessions with the DPC. (DURING PANDEMIC TELE COUNSELLING/ SKYPE COUNSELLING IS ALSO OPEN)
6. Interested students are required to fill up the Consent Form to reserve the admission for the IB & IGCSE Diploma Programme. (ONLINE FORMS CAN BE FILLED UP IN PANDEMIC)
7. **For IBDP students are encouraged to opt for full diploma by proper counseling.**
8. Orientation cum Bridge Course SUMMER PROGRAMME is conducted for the interested and admitted students with an introduction and concluding session by the DPC and sample classes for all the subjects on offer. (THIS YEAR ORIENTATION PROGRAMME HAS BEEN PLANNED ON VIRTUAL PLATFORM)



Admission Procedure:

1. The School Brochure, Admission form and a kit of other relevant forms is available at the reception at IIS, Jaipur.
2. Entire details like eligibility criteria, availability of forms and last date of submission is available on school web: www.iisjaipur.org
3. All applications duly filled are to be submitted on or before the last date.
4. The students seeking admission IN IGCSE/ IBDP also have an interactive session with the University Counselor for guidance on the selection of subjects/level based on their future career prospects.
5. The subject options are finalized by the Programme Head after final counseling. Which is further approved by university counsellor and DPC. Any change of subject/levels is allowed till August/SEPTEMBER
6. Original DOCUMENTS will have to be produced at the time of admission for verification.
7. All applications must be accompanied with
 - i. FOUR passport size photographs
 - ii. Attested copy of the Mark sheet of class X exam
 - iii. Attested copy of birth certificate
 - iv. School Leaving Certificate.
 - v. Health Certificate from the family doctor.
 - vi. Migration Certificate (for the students of other board)
 - vii. Character certificate from the principal of previous school



8. Review / checking of the Admission Form is done by the Admission officer.
9. For eligible students entrance tests to determine the student's proficiency in Math and English may be conducted. The language proficiency test may be conducted to determine the aptitude and to guide the students for the language options offered in IBDP & IGCSE.
10. Intimation to the parents regarding the interaction date is communicated in due course.
11. Information to be conveyed to the parents about the admission status of their ward.
12. Submission of Application Form does not ensure admission to the school.
13. A student is admitted on a provisional basis till all necessary documents are completed.
14. Fees have to be paid on or before the due date.
15. The fee structure is subject to change at the discretion of the school management.
16. After confirmation of admission the student is expected to undergo a complete medical checkup and the report submitted to the school office before the commencement of the school. The report should not be more than 60 days old.
17. In case any relevant information has been withheld deliberately, the school may review the admission of the student.
18. The decision of the school authorities regarding admission is final and binding.
