Dear Parents,

As per the recommendations of NCFSE 2023, CBSE has implemented the structured three language framework from class VI with effect from the academic session 2026-27. Though this major change was announced by CBSE on 2<sup>nd</sup> April 2026, the school has adapted to the same and has a plan in place. As per the 3 Language formula, it is mandatory for every learner to study at least two languages native to India. Accordingly, our students of grade 6 will now study English as R1, Hindi as R2 and Sanskrit as R3.

With a continued focus on languages and a culture of multilingualism at IIS, we believe that knowing a foreign language is always beneficial. Taking this forward, all students will also study French or Japanese as an **Additional Language Course** in grade VI -2026-27 which will be continued further in grade VII - 2027-28 and grade VIII - 2028-29, enabling students of middle stage to be competent in one foreign language.

The transaction of the syllabus/content for R3 – Sanskrit and the Additional Language Course will be done through modules and does not entail any additional expense to be borne by the parent in the form of books or any other study material.
