
The event culminated with the Group Dance segment, where each house presented thought-provoking themes through creative choreography and synchronized movements.

BEHIND TOYS








SCIENCE A Science Quiz was organized on 11th August for grade 5

Investiture Ceremony -



The Principal, Ms. Nidhi Mishra ma'am congratulated and blessed the new leaders. A spark of enthusiasm and commitment was seen in the eyes of
















HAR GHAR F TIRANGA


