follow up their thoughts in actions.

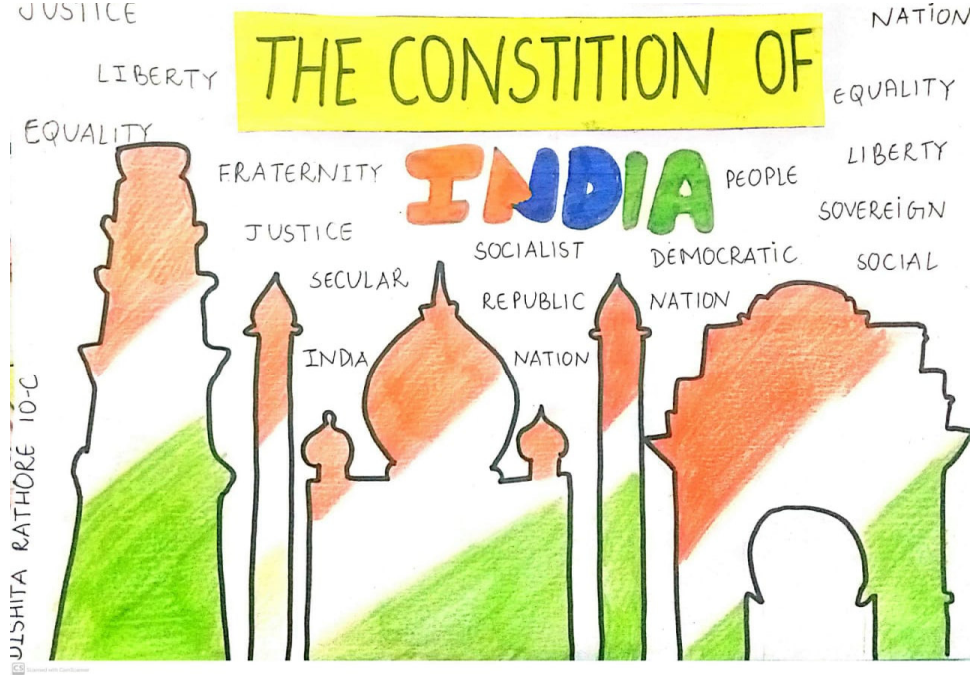
Equality-It is one of the fundamental right. This
